



INTERNATIONAL® DETAILED FEATURES

Penn's International[®] reels are strong and relatively simple to operate. Take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the operating controls and quality features listed below before using your Penn International[®] reel.

- Machine-Cut, Heat-Treated Stainless Steel Main and Pinion Gears, and Drag Cam International reels feature specially tempered (hardened) stainless steel gears. Gears are the guts of any fishing reel, but especially so with lever drag reels. Penn's one piece pinion and main gears in the International reels are likely to never fail.
- **Penn Lever Drag** Provides 150 degrees (120 on International[®] II) of drag adjustment, from free, with no drag pressure, to strike, where you strike and fight the fish, to full, which provides an extra few pounds of drag pressure when you need it. "Free" and "Strike" buttons serve as quick and easy reference points. A Strip-Drag feature is found on Penn International[®] V series reels, which helps eliminate backlashes from overruns in freespool.
- Powerful and Smooth Double-Disc Dura-Drag[™] International[®] V series and Two-Speed International[®] II series reels feature a double-disc drag system for increased fish-stopping power.
- **Graduated Push-to-Turn Preset** The pre-set knob on the International[®] V series features a unique locking feature. To operate the locking pre-set knob, first push the knob in, then turn clockwise to increase drag, turn counter-clockwise to decrease drag. This feature eliminates drag pre-set fluctuation due to rough seas, engine vibrations, or tampering anglers.
- Aircraft-Grade, Sealed, Stainless Steel Ball Bearings All International[®] models feature four sealed stainless steel ball bearings of the highest quality for smooth free spooling and retrieves.
- Machined, Gold Anodized One-Piece Frame Over-designed in terms of strength, the machined, gold anodized one-piece frame of an International reel is built for landing world-record sized fish. Rich gold-anodizing, signature of the Penn International[®], is not only impressive looking on the docks, but serves to protect the machined frame from the harsh marine environment. Distinctive pure gold color separates Penn from the impostors.
- Forged & Machined Spool and Side Plates Penn's International[®] spools and side plates are forged, machined and gold anodized for strength and resistance to corrosion.
- **Penn Fighting Handle** Designed for comfort through the longest battles, the Penn Fighting Handle automatically orients to a vertical position for fast, easy gripping.
- Quick Shift International® V series reels feature an easy to operate, one-touch shift feature that automatically engages high or low gear with the push of a button or twist of a knob. Gears are instantly engaged, without the need to manipulate the handle position.

CARE AND LUBRICATION

Your Penn International[®]reel is quality manufactured for maximum durability. Like any other precision-made piece of equipment, reasonable care will ensure peak performance and longevity.

After each fishing trip, the reel should be cleaned with a soap solution and fresh water, preferably warm, to remove any accumulated salt deposits.

When washing the reel, use caution not to use a driving force of water, since the water pressure will force salt deposits and/or sand into the reel. A very fine spray will help dissolve the salt on the external parts of the reel and rinse from the reel.

Dry excess moisture from the reel and then sparingly lubricate all exposed areas. A good practice is to spray a rag with a pressurized spray lubricant and wipe down the reels with the rag. Your reel should be stored in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a plastic bag, as condensation may develop.

Periodically examine your reel and tighten loose screws and fittings. Depending upon use, your reel should be overhauled at least once every season.

Frictional points in the reel should be frequently lubricated, and for best results use Penn lubricant. Penn's tubes of lube are the right formula, designed specifically for Penn Reels. Keep in mind, that a few drops of oil is usually sufficient

Major points for external lubrication include: Clicker button, Handle knob (on 130 size this may require the removal of the handle knob screws), locating pins (strike and free).
