Infinite Anti-Reverse (IAR): Heavy-Duty Stainless Steel anti-reverse bearing provides instant, infinite anti-reverse, eliminating handle "kick back" for rock solid hook sets and improved smoothness.

Leveline™ Spool Wrap System: Penn Leveline™ extends the throw at both extremes of spool oscillation, resulting in a flat, level, line wrap, ideal for all line types including braid.



Full Metal Body - For strength and durability, the Slammer®'s die cast housing, side plate and rotor are anodized and then powder-coat painted for the ultimate in corrosion resistance

Stainless Steel Ball Bearings: 5 + 1 high-quality, shielded, stainless steel bearings are incorporated into the Slammer. Unlike gimmicky unshielded, bearings that clog with contaminants and salt buildup, Penn's high-grade stainless steel ball bearings were designed for performance in a marine environment. Just remember, high-grade Stainless is better than coated, non-shielded bearings.

Sealed Drag Knob: Water and contaminants are prevented from depositing onto the drag washers courtesy of the sealed drag knob, keeping your drag in peak performance.

Gold Anodized Handle: For improved corrosion resistance, the handle is gold anodized. For convenience, the handle easily converts to right-hand drive for left-handed anglers.

Fail Free Bail Spring: Building upon Penn's already reliable bail system, Penn's Fail Free bail spring provides consistent and proven performance.

Stainless Steel Spool Shaft. - Large diameter for extra strength and rigidity. Triple supported for extra-heavy duty fishing.

Penn Power Drag. - A single, large drag washer, under the spool to keep it protected from the elements, provides the utmost in smooth stopping power for the Slammer®'s drag system. The proven drag material lasts long, but when it finally does wear, the washer's reversible for even longer life.

Heavy Duty Bail Assembly. - Machined aluminum bail arm offers strength not found in ordinary spinning reels. Stainless steel bail features crisp, positive action.

Extra Large Line Roller System. - Extra large stainless steel ball bearing line roller for friction-free fishing.

Heavy Duty, Precision-Cut Gears: Strong, powerful gears, are taken to the next level of performance with new precision-cut gears found in the Slammer®. Silky-smooth performance combined with the power and torque necessary for landing large gamefish.

Machined, Anodized Aluminum Spool. - Lightweight aluminum for easy casting, machined for strength and anodized for protection against the elements. Your Penn Reel is quality manufactured for maximum durability. Like any other precision-made piece of equipment, reasonable care will ensure peak performance and longevity.

After each fishing trip, the reel should be cleaned with a soap solution and fresh water, preferably warm, to remove any accumulated salt deposits.

When washing the reel, use caution not to use a driving force of water, since the water pressure will force salt deposits and/or sand into the reel. A very fine spray will help dissolve the salt on the external parts of the reel and rinse it from the reel.

Dry excess moisture from the reel and then sparingly lubricate all exposed areas. A good practice is to spray a rag with a pressurized spray lubricant and wipe down the reels with the rag. Your reel should be stored in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a plastic bag, as condensation may develop.

Periodically examine your reel and tighten loose screws and fittings. Depending upon use, your reel should be overhauled at least once every season.

Frictional points in the reel should be frequently lubricated, and for best results use Penn lubricant. Penn's tubes of lube are the right formula, designed specifically for Penn Reels. Keep in mind, that a few drops of oil is usually sufficient

Major points for external lubrication include: Handle knob and components, bail arm, bail cam and line roller.

OUT OF SERVICE WARRANTY

For non-warranty service to your Penn reel, simply return the reel with a brief note describing the service you want performed. Available on the Penn website (www.pennreels.com) is a repair form that we suggest is completed and returned with each reel for more efficient processing. Penn strives to complete all repairs in a timely manner.
